DISCUSSION

- Distribution of Opioid Settlement Funds to purchase Naloxone for city fleet first aid kits and police officer
- Johnson & Johnson settlement agreement

NALOXONE FUNDING REQUEST

Situation

- February 29, 2024, Island County Health Department provide Opioid Safety and Naloxone Training to city staff from Public Works, Parks, and Marina staff.
- The training covered proper use of personal protective equipment and safety around suspected opioid material and the application of Naloxone as a first aid tool to counter an opioid exposure or overdoses.
- City Staff identified the need to outfit city fleet first aid kits with Naloxone.
- There is no inventory of Naloxone owned by the city and Naloxone can not be provided by Island County services.



NALOXONE FUNDING REQUEST

Action

- Request of \$5,500.00 from the Opioid Future Allocation Fund to purchase 100 boxes of Naloxone from an approved vender.

100 boxes Naloxone x \$55.00 each = Total Cost \$5,500

- \$149.5 million State
 - Half to State
 - Half to Counties & Cities
