Occupational and Operational Safety: We finished May with ZERO days lost from COVID issues and zero reported positive cases; stations have been re-opened to personnel immediate family members.

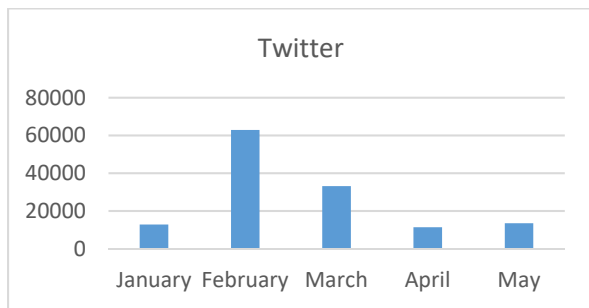
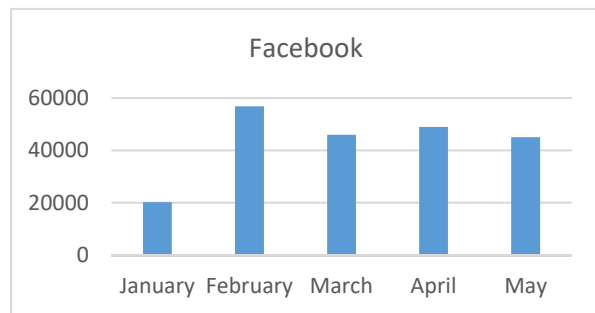
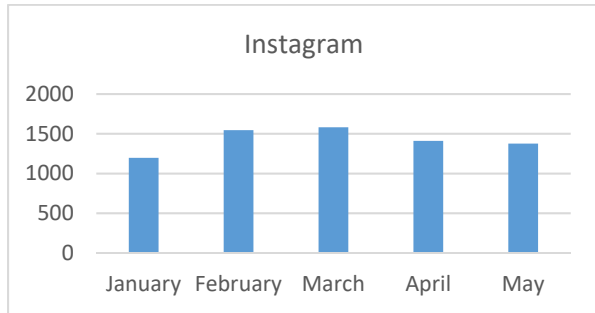
No reported injuries from the construction project at Station 133 in the month of May.
